


team was through Team Focus. The first time I learned how to tie a tie, how to fish, my first etiquette class, and even my first experience with a job interview was all through Team Focus.

Someone believed that I could one day do something that statistics suggest I would never do. I couldn't believe it. I rode those words... ...l rode those words to a collegiate career in basketball where I played at Universidad del Sagrado Corazon, and I was blessed to play at the pro level in Puerto Rico as well.
